Graduate students who have been accepted for graduate study by a department of the University. It does not indicate that they received admission to candidacy.

## FULL-TIME EQUIVALENCY ENROLLMENT

Computation is based upon an agreement between the three state universities and the Board of Regents. The total hours for which all stduents are enrolled at the end of the second week (effective Fall 2004) of Fall/Spring semester, and the final enrollment of the summer session are determined. These are added together to determine the total hours for the year. Undergraduate hours are divided by 30 and gradaute hours by 18 to determine a full-time equivalent.
