Salary increases for instructional faculty are made annually consistent with the collective bargaining agreement between the State of Iowa Board of Regents and the UNI-United Faculty. For FY 2003, the average increase of 5.6 percent included a 3.00% increase applied across-the-board to last year's base salary, an incremental step increase of \$515 and individual merit adjustments determined by department heads.

Academic administrative faculty and institutional officials were awarded an average salary increase of 5.6 percent based on merit/performance.
